Chief Vigilance Officer in the scale of pay of Rs.24900-50500 (Pre-revised Rs. 13000-18250) in Cochin Port Trust on deputation basis from officers holding analogous posts or officers holding posts in the pay scale of Rs. 10750 -16750 with 4 years of regular service in the grade, failing which, officers of a combined regular service of 9 years in the scales of pay of Rs. 10750-16750 and 9100-15100 in any Major Port Trusts/Central Govt./State Govt./Semi Govt./Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous bodies. 3. No-Objection Certificate of the respective organization.

The applicants should have at least 3 years' service left as on 01.04.2015 for retirement on superannuation in the parent organization for deputation posting.

The applicant from Non-Port Sector should substantiate the equivalence of his/her pay scale to the requisite pay scale to prove the eligibility.

The applications received through proper channel only will be entertained. The applications received after the last date or without ACRs or otherwise incomplete will not be considered.
