

APPLICATION ARE INVITED FOR THE POST OF CHIEF MECHANICAL ENGINEER, COCHIN PORT TRUST BY ABSORPTION THROUGH COMPOSITE METHOD FROM ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES OF MAJOR PORT TRUSTS

1. Applications are invited for filling up the post of Chief Mechanical Engineer in the scale of pay of Rs. 43200-66000 (pre-revised Rs.18500-450-23900) in Cochin Port Trust by absorption through composite method as per the Recruitment Rules (**Annexure –I**).
2. The post is to be filled by absorption through composite method from officers holding analogous posts or officers holding posts in the scale of pay of Rs.17500-22300 (Revised Rs.36600-62000) with two years regular service in the grade or Officers holding the posts in the scale of pay of Rs.16000-20800 (Revised Rs.32900-58000) with three years regular service in the grade in the M& E Engg. Dept. and Marine Dept.(applicable to categories of Marine Engineers only) in a Major Port Trust will be eligible. The requisite educational & other qualifications prescribed as per Recruitment Rules are:-
Essential : Degree or equivalent in Mechanical/Electrical/Electronics & Communication Engineering/ Naval Architecture from a recognized University /Institution. OR MOT Ist Class Motor Certificate issued under Merchant Shipping Act 1958.
3. The selection is by merit for which the benchmark in overall grading in the ACRs will not be below “Very Good”.
4. How to apply
 - a) Eligible and willing Officers who satisfy the provisions of Recruitment Rules for the post of Chief Mechanical Engineer may apply online in the “Online Application Portal (OAP)” of the Ministry of Shipping (<http://onlinevacancy.shipmin.nic.in>). The applicant has to register in the Online Application Portal.
 - b) A print out of the Online filled up application should be submitted through proper channel along with the following documents in an envelope, superscribing ‘*Application for the post of Chief Mechanical Engineer in Cochin Port Trust on absorption basis*’ to the Secretary, Cochin Port Trust, Willingdon Island, Cochin-682 009 on or before 28.03.2019.
 - i. Attested copies of Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs/ACRs) of the applicant for the last 5 years (01.04.2013 to 31.03.2018) (Attested by an Officer not below the rank of Dy. HOD on each page).
 - ii. A statement showing year-wise availability of ACRs and grading duly signed by the Dy. Chairman/Chairman. If the ACR of a particular period during the last 5 years is not available, “No Report Certificate” may be furnished.
 - iii. Attested copies of Certificates of academic qualifications & experience to prove eligibility.
 - iv. No-Objection certificate of the concerned Port Trust.

- v. An undertaking of the applicant not to withdraw his candidature, if selected.(As per Ministry's direction, Officials, who withdraws his candidature for the Post after his selection by the Services Selection Committee, will be liable for debarment from future selection to HOD level posts in all Major Port Trusts for a period of three years).
 - vi. Certificate by Head of office of the applicant as per **Annexure-II**.
 - vii. Vigilance and Administrative Clearance of the concerned organization in the Proforma prescribed by the Ministry (**Annexure-III**).
 - viii. Two recent passport size photographs in a sealed envelope.
 - ix. The Veracity of the University Certificates produced by the applicants and the recognition of the degree obtained by the applicant may be certified by the concerned officer of the Port.
- c) The applications which are received after due date/not sent through proper channel will not be considered. The last date of receipt of applications is 28-03-2019.
