India Gateway Terminal Private Ltd on 1st April 2005 which was in operation by them till the commissioning of new terminal at Vallarpadam. Phase-I of ICTT consisting of construction of 600m berth & development of stacking area and other allied facilities has been

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					commissioned on 11th February, 2011. The ICTT is running at 35% capacity and is subject to constant review.
