



 March of that year failing which the amount may lapse.
- This order will be in force till the closure of the scholarship years.
- 6. The payment will be made in annual instalments. The first instalment will be paid in lump sum immediately after the issue of this order, without production of any certificate. The succeeding annual instalment will be made in lump sum only on production of certificates from the Head of Educational Institution that the student is continuing his/her studies in the next higher class at the beginning of the concerned academic year and his / her conduct are good.
- 7. The recipients of the Scholarship are advised to verify their names initials and other particulars appearing in the order Discrepancies, if any should be brought to the notice of the Senior Welfare Officer, Cochin Port Trust immediately Any change in College where the student studies should also be intimated to the Senior Welfare Officer, and the respective Drawing Officers immediately.
