Employees of Cochin Port to contribute one day's salary to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund

The employees of Cochin Port Trust will contribute their one day's salary for the relief of the flood affected people of Kerala. This decision was taken in a meeting held in Cochin Port by the management and employee unions of Cochin Port Trust today. The contribution of employees amounting to Rs.31 lakhs and an equal amount from Cochin Port Trust funds (total 62 Lakhs) will be handed over to the Chief Minister's Relief Fund, informed Shri A V Ramana, Chairman (i/c), Cochin Port Trust.

The employees of Cochin Port Trust have also decided to call off their onam celebrations and contribute the money earmarked for onam celebrations for the relief work. The employees have decided to form volunteer teams and reach out to the needy people in the flood affected area and carry out the relief work in the coming days, in consultation with the Government authorities.
