## NOTICE INVITING TENDER

1. Electronic Tenders (**e-tenders**) on percentage basis are invited by Cochin Port Trust from reputed contractors in Single Stage Two Cover bidding procedure [Technical Bid and Financial Bid], meeting the Minimum Eligibility Criteria specified below for the work of **“Construction of Jetty and Allied Facilities for Indian Coast Guard at Fort Kochi”**.

2. **Minimum Eligibility Criteria:**

**a) Experience**

The tenderers should have experience of having successfully completed during the last 7 (seven) years ending **31<sup>st</sup> March 2018**, at least either:

i) Three similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 2777.67 lakhs**

**(OR)**

ii) Two similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 3472.09 lakhs**

**(OR)**

iii) One similar works each costing not less than **Rs. 5555.34 lakhs**

**b) Financial Turnover**

Average Financial Turnover of the tenderer over the last three financial years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March of the previous financial year [2014-'15, 2015-'16 & 2016-'17] shall not be less than **Rs.2083.25 lakhs**.

**Explanatory notes to a) & b) :**

**Note 1:- Similar work(s) means “Construction of a berth/ jetty/ bridge/ marine structure in sea/ river/ backwater/ marine environment with bored cast in situ pile foundation”**

**Note 2:-** Following enhancement factors will be used for the costs of works executed for bringing the financial figures to a common base value in respect of the works completed in past years.

**Note 3:-** *The experience certificate of works executed in private sectors/organisations shall be considered for qualification, only on submission of TDS certificate along with work order and completion certificate.*

**Note 4:-** *Satisfactory Client/owners's Certificate or documentary proof shall be submitted in support of the assignments / works performed and claimed by the tenderer to fulfill the eligibility criteria for qualification. A statement duly certified by the Chartered accountant showing the average annual Financial Turnover over the last 3 financial years and audited financial statements for the last three years shall be submitted.*

**Note 5:-** *The works reckoned for the above purpose are those executed by the tenderers as prime contractor or proportionately as member of joint venture or as a sub contractor, authorized and approved by the Employer of the work(s) against which the tenderer has claimed his experience.*

**Note 6:-** *In case of bid submitted by JV/ Consortium, the Minimum Eligibility Criteria EXCEPT Financial Turnover can be fulfilled collectively by the Partners of the JV/ Consortium.*

**Note 7:-** *In the case of bid submitted by JV/ Consortium, the lead partner of the JV shall meet the Minimum Eligibility Criteria of Financial Turnover.*

### **3. Other Eligibility Considerations**

3.1 Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- i) made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
- ii) record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.

3.2 The bidders having EPF/ ESI registration certificates shall only be considered for qualification in the tenders.

5. This work essentially comprises of

**A. Civil works for the following facilities:**

a) Construction of Jetty comprising the following:

- (i) A 220m long and 15m wide Jetty head with open type construction supported on 1000mm dia bored cast-in-situ piles founded at (-) 60 to (-)65m CD in the backwaters including fixing of rubber fenders and cast steel bollards. The deck is of RCC beam and slab construction and the beams are combination of pre-cast and cast-in-situ portions.
- (ii) An approach bridge of about 72m length with 10m wide carriage way with open type construction supported on 1000mm dia bored cast-in-situ piles founded at about (-)55 to (-)60m CD in the backwaters. The deck is of RCC beam and slab construction and the beams are combination of pre-cast and cast-in-situ portions.

b) Construction of a Single Storied building of size 7.8m x 4.5m with mezzanine floor of 2.2m x 4.5m size for Firefighting pump house supported on bored cast-in-situ piles of 1000mm diameter founded at about (-)43m to (-) 50m CD in the backwaters.

**B. Mechanical works which consists of the following:**

- i) Design, Supply, Fabrication, installation, testing and commissioning of Fixed Fire Fighting Facilities at the Jetty, which consists of Motor driven vertical Turbine pump along with compatible motor, and fire fighting distribution network consisting of 250mm header line and 150mm branching lines leading to Jetty Head.
- ii) Providing and laying pipelines using Galvanised Carbon Steel ERW pipes through ducts provided on both sides of the jetty (lee and sea side) for facilitating compressed air supply with necessary FRL fittings at Jetty head.

**C. Electrical works which consists of the following:**

Providing LT supply to Indian Coast Guard Jetty at Fort Kochi and providing electrical facilities for vessels shore supply points, cope points crane supply points, electrical fire fighting water pump motor, lights, electrification of pump house, auxiliary systems at jetty.

6. Tender documents can be downloaded from the e-Tendering portal [www.tenderwizard.com/COPT](http://www.tenderwizard.com/COPT) on the dates specified in the above table by making online requisition. Bid document will also be available in Cochin Port website ([www.cochinport.gov.in](http://www.cochinport.gov.in)) as well as Govt. tender website, [www.tenders.gov.in](http://www.tenders.gov.in), which can be downloaded for submission. The cost of bid document shall be furnished in the form of Demand Draft/ Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of FA & CAO, CoPT along with the

submission of bid.

7. The bidders need to obtain the one time User ID & password for log-in to in **e-Tendering** system from the service provider **KEONICS** by paying registration amount of **Rs.1124/-** by online Payment using Credit/Debit Card/Net banking or DD in favour of “KSEDCL, Bangalore”.
8. The intending bidder must have valid Class-II or III digital signature certificate to submit the bid. For further details and to obtain the digital signature, please contact e-Tender Help Desk No.080-40482000 / 9746118529.
9. Tenders shall be submitted “**online**” strictly in accordance with the Instructions to Tenderers and Terms & Conditions given in the tender document.
10. The bidder is responsible to download Addenda/ Amendments/ Errata/ Replies to the queries of the bidders etc., if any, issued by the Employer, from the website before submission of the bid. Any shortfall in submissions of the said Addenda/ Amendments/Errata/Replies to the queries of the bidders duly signed etc. along with the downloaded documents while submitting the bid will not be considered. Incomplete bid documents may be rejected.
11. All bids are to be submitted **online only** on the website [www.tenderwizard.com/COPT](http://www.tenderwizard.com/COPT). No Bids shall be accepted off-line (Hard copy).
12. Cochin Port Trust will not be held responsible for any technical snag or net work failure during online bidding. It is the bidder’s responsibility to comply with the system requirements i.e. hardware, software and internet connectivity at bidder’s premises, to access the e-Tender portal. Under any circumstances, Cochin Port Trust shall not be liable to the bidders for any direct/indirect loss or damages incurred by them arising out of incorrect use of the e-Tender system or internet connectivity failures.
13. The bidder shall submit Originals of (i) DD / Bankers Cheque / BG towards the cost of tender and EMD, (ii) Power of Attorney in favour of signatory(s) to the tender and (iii) Integrity Pact along with letter of submission in a sealed cover **to the Chief Engineer, Cochin Port Trust, W/Island, Cochin – 682009, KERALA**, before opening date and time of the tender. **Non submission of original financial documents towards cost of Tender document, EMD and Integrity Pact, before opening date and time, of the tender will make the tender be liable for rejection.**
14. Bidders who are registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Govt. of India enterprises under “Single Point Registration Scheme” of Ministry of MSME shall be eligible for issue of tender document free of cost and exemption from payment of Earnest Money Deposit. They are required to submit documentary proof of such registration along with the offer, as detailed in Instructions to Tenderers, for claiming the available exemptions and also, a scanned copy of the Exemption Certificate duly notarized shall be uploaded in the e-tendering Portal.
15. **Integrity Pact (IP)** shall cover this tender throughout its various phases, and IP would be deemed as a part of the contract through an appropriate provision. The bidders should sign and submit an “Integrity Pact” to be executed between the bidder and Cochin Port Trust along with the bid in a separate envelope superscribed “Integrity Pact” in Technical Bid. Bids not accompanied by a duly signed “Integrity Pact” shall be liable for rejection.
