

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of even number dated 30.09.2017 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that the Competent Authority has approved the amendment regarding the posting of doctors after attaining their age of 62 years, Accordingly, in exercise of power conferred under Section 111 of the Major Port Trusts Act 1963, the Ministry of Shipping, in line with the decision taken by the competent authority, has decided that the following decisions may be implemented in the Major Port Trusts with immediate effect, pending amendment In relevant regulations:

- The doctors on attaining the age of 62 years, shall stand retired unless they exercise the option of posting to non-administrative 1 position as decided by the Chairman of Major Port Trust, in case they wish to continue in service up to 65 years.
- Doctors will require to exercise the option not less than 6 months before their attaining age of 62 years. The serving doctors who ii. have either already attained the age of 62 years or attaining the age of 62 years within 6 months, may exercise option within 30 days from the date of issuance of this order.
- Depending on the field of their expertise/experience, Major Port Trusts will create floating posts with appropriate designation up ili. to/not more than 5% of the respective cadre strength for posting of doctors who attain the age of 62 years. No separate approval will be required in this regard.
- Except in case where Port is in the opinion that entitlements are functionally not essentially required for smooth and efficient IV. discharge of the duties and responsibilities of the post held by such doctors after attaining the age of 62 years, the pay, allowances and other entitlements of such doctors will not be altered to their disadvantages,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letters of even number dated 30.09.2017 and 10.12.2018 (copies enclosed), wherein the decision to enhance the superannuation age of medical doctors to 65 years along with guidelines for implementation were conveyed to the Major Port Trusts. As per the aforementioned directions, a medical officer on reaching the age of 62 years shall stand retired unless he/she exercises the option of posting to non-administrative position, in case they wish to continue in service up to 65 years. In order to accommodate such doctors who opt to continue in non-administrative positions till 65 years, Major Port Trusts were to create floating posts with appropriate designation up to/not more than 5% of the respective cadre strength.

2. However, it was informed by some Ports that they are unable to adjust all the medical officers who opt to continue in service up to 65 years due to creation of inadequate number of floating posts on account of the ceiling of 5% of cadre strength on the number of such posts. The matter has been examined in consultation with the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and a decision has been taken with the approval of the competent authority to remove the ceiling limit of 5% for creation of floating posts in order to accommodate doctors who have opted to continue in service beyond the age of 62 years in non-administrative positions.

3. Accordingly, upon reaching the age of 62 years, a medical officer shall stand retired unless they exercise the option of continuing in service till the age

of 65 years by posting to a non-administrative position. All such doctors who opt to continue in service beyond 62 years will be adjusted in nonadministrative posts. The Ports may adjust such doctors by creating floating posts without any limit on the number of such posts.

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4. Clause iii of Ministry's letter dated 10.12.2018 accordingly stands modified. All other terms and conditions mentioned in Ministry's letters dated 30.09.2017 and 10.12.2018 will remain unchanged. Ports may take necessary action accordingly.

3. 4. The retirement vacancy of Shri M.S.Shibu is kept unfilled as the vacancy is earmarked for SC quota and no SC candidates available in the feeder post of Junior Engineer Gr-I for filling up the vacancy.

5. Further Shri Uthaman, Asst.Engineer, Civil Engg. Dept who has been posted in the place of Smt.A.Sheeja would require time to gain experience to effectively perform in Estate Division.

6. It is therefore requested to make arrangments on priority basis to appoint two Civil Engineers, preferably retired officers from the Port having diploma/degree in Civil Engineering and experience in Estate matters, on contract basis in Estate division at Asst.Engineer /Asst.Exe.Engineer level for effective functioning of the Estate Division. Also requested to consider Shri M.S.Shibu, Asst.Engineer retired on 30.04.2023 for appointment on contract basis immediately until a formal contract appointment of two Civil Engineers.



7. In this regard, the MoPSW vide letter dt.24th January 2022 (refer) has conveyed the decision of the Ministry that contract appointment of retired Port employees shall ordinarily be for an initial period not exceeding one

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year which is extendable by another one year. Beyond two years age of superannuation where adequate justification exists, the term may be extended based on a review of the task and the performance of the contract appointee, provided it shall not be extended beyond 5 years after superannuation. Also directed to strictly adhere to the above decision of the Ministry and no retired port employees shall be appointed on contract basis in any capacity beyond the age of 65 years.

8.Further the MoPSW vide OM dt.16.02.2021 (refer) has issued comprehensive guidelines for engagement of retired Government officers/officials as Consultant in MoPSW and stated that attached/subordinate/Autonomous organisations under this Ministry may use these guidelines, if they find fit for their Organizations.

9.Wherein, at clause 3 (refer), instructions are given for fixing remuneration for engagement of retired Govt.Officers/officials as consultant in MoPSW.

10.Accordingly, total monthly remuneration and pension drawn by the consultant shall not be more than the Last pay drawn by him. A fixed monthly amount shall be admissible, arrived at by deducting the basic pension from the pay drawn at the time of retirement. The amount of remuneration so fixed shall remain unchanged for the term of the contract. There will be no annual increment/percentage increase during the contract period. The commuted portion of pension shall also be included in the portion of pension to be deducted.


