

Cochin Port hosts All India Major Ports Volleyball and Beach Volleyball Championships

The All India Major Ports Volleyball and Beach Volleyball Championships commenced today at Cochin Port, Willingdon Island. About 120 players representing nine Major Ports from across the country viz. Chennai, Kolkata, Mumbai, Goa (Mormugao), Mangalore, Paradip, Tuticorin, Visakhapatnam, and Cochin are participating in the tournament.
