Sub: Rate contract for hiring of Mobile Crane of 17 tone lifting capacity for facilitating the repairs of Navigational Buoys/handling of other miscellaneous works at CoPA for a period of one year or until the CoPA's MHC becomes operational, whichever is earlier, :- Reg

Cochin Port Authority invites competitive quotations in sealed cover from reputed firms for hiring of one number mobile Crane with operator, meeting the following requirements :-

Sl. No.	Description of work
1	Hiring One Number mobile Crane of lifting capacity of not less than 17 Tons having sufficient boom length with operator/fuel etc with and all valid statutory certificates. Scope of work and Terms & Conditions enumerated below.

The bidder shall quote the lowest lump sum minimum hire charges for initial One hour in a day and also quote additional hourly charges in the same day separately excluding GST for the above rate contract of crane hiring. Any additional hours worked beyond one hour in the same day will be paid additional as per the hourly rate quoted by the vender. The Normal working time will be between 08.30 hrs to 16.00 hrs in week days.

Quotation should be sent in sealed cover to the under signed **in the below mentioned prescribed price schedule format itself signed with seal, so as to reach on or before 11.00 Hrs on 07-05-2026. The quotations will be opened at 11.30 Hrs on the same day.**

Terms & conditions

1. The quotation No. & date may be super scribed on the sealed envelope
2. **The bidder shall quote the lowest lump sum minimum hire charges for initial One hour in a day (normal working time between 08.30 hrs to 16.00 hrs) and also quote additional hourly hire charges in the same day separately excluding GST** for the above rate contract of crane hiring. Any additional hours worked beyond initial one hour in the same day will be paid additional as per the hourly rate quoted by the vender.
3. The quotation should be sent by post or directly addressed to "Superintending Engineer(M), Office of the Deputy Conservator, Cochin Port Authority, Cochin -682 009" in sealed cover as per the above price schedule, so as to reach on or before **11.00 Hrs on 07-05-2026**.
4. The period of contract is One year period from the date of CoPA work order or until the CoPA's MHC becomes operational, whichever is earlier.
5. The hire charges quoted shall be valid for One year period from the date of CoPA work order or until the CoPA's MHC becomes operational, whichever is earlier.
6. The sum of the **Lump sum Minimum hire charge quoted for initial One hour in a day and the rate quoted for additional one hour in the same day excluding GST will be considered for evaluation purpose by CoPA.**
7. If the contract awarded, the contractor shall furnish copy of all valid statutory certificates of crane and its operator to CoPA before starting the each days lifting work.
8. On each call made by Cope by telephone/email, the crane shall be available for the works at CoPA premises as per the requirement of works. The requirement of crane will be informed to the contractor by telephone one day in advance by the Engineer in charge of the contract
9. If the crane becomes unavailable for COPA's usage during the course of work in a day due to contractors reasons, hire charges for such unavailable hours will not be paid. Hire charge will be paid only for the actual available hours of the crane in accordance with the quoted rates approved by CoPA.

10. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to comply with all statutory/safety requirements for operating the crane at CoPA premises. The Contractor shall take all statutory/safety approvals and CoPA entry passes wherever required at your risk and cost, from Authorities before entering the crane to work site and starting the work at CoPA site and Cochin Port Authority shall not be responsible for such liabilities.
11. Site clearance for entry of crane will be in the scope of CoPA only inside the CoPA wharfs/sites.
12. Any trade union problem, disturbance of electric /telephone line etc and any other hindrance during the travel of crane to CoPA site shall be managed by the contractor.
13. Hire charges shall be applicable from the time of crane reached at CoPA wharf gate.
14. Entry pass for the Crane and its operators shall be arranged by the contractor at his cost and risk.
15. The Contract is liable to be terminated forthwith in case of any illegal act or breach of terms & conditions on the part of the contractor, unsatisfactory service including continuous breakdown happens repeatedly and the Contractor fails to repair the defect etc.
16. Payment will be made after the completion of each day's work and after submission of **GST invoice** certified by the Engineer in charge of the contract.
17. GST will be paid additional as per the prevailing rate on submission of GST invoice after the successful completion of each day work.
18. IT and GST TDS if applicable will be deducted as per the prevailing rates in force at the time of payment of bills from each invoice.
19. The responsibility of operating the crane for handling(lifting/lowering) of Launches/ Dingy/Navigational Buoys/any other items as per the instruction of the Engineer in charge of CoPA, in a safe manner as per Standard Engineering Practices/Requirements and also complying all applicable statutory/safety requirements vests with the Contractor.
20. In case any loss or damage occurs during the operation of the crane to the property of CoPA or to any person or third party properties due to erroneous operation or due to failure/malfunction of the crane, the contractor agrees to indemnify CoPA and make good such damages/losses at the cost and risk of the contractor, to the satisfaction of CoPA.
21. Cochin Port Authority reserves the right to reject/cancel/postpone any one or all Bids at any stage of the Bid, which will be binding on all Bidders.
22. Legal jurisdiction of this contract shall be Kochi City only.
