1. Notice Inviting Tender

1. Electronic Tenders (**e-tenders**) on percentage basis are invited by Cochin Port Authority from reputed contractors in Single Stage Two Cover bidding procedure [Technical Bid and Financial Bid], meeting the Minimum Eligibility Criteria specified below for the work of “**Re-Surfacing of Bristow Road & Construction of Footpath with Drain & Utility Duct from Hospital Jn. to Udaan Gate Jn. at W/Island**”.

2. **Minimum Eligibility Criteria (MEC)**

- a) **Experience**

The tenderers should have experience of having successfully completed or substantially completed the works mentioned below during the last 7 (seven) years ending 30th June 2026, at least either:

- i) Three similar works each costing not less than **Rs.9,13,04,840/-**

(OR)

- ii) Two similar works each costing not less than **Rs.11,41,31,050/-**

(OR)

- iii) One similar work costing not less than **Rs. 18,26,09,680/-**

Note:

- i) In case of substantial completion, the certificate shall be produced as substantially completed.
 - ii) Ongoing works with minimum 90% financial progress also will be considered for Experience of MEC supported by satisfactory progress and performance certification by the Employer.

b) Financial Turnover

Average Financial Turnover of the tenderer over the last three financial years ending 31st March 2025 of the previous financial year [2022-'23, 2023-'24 & 2024-'25] shall not be less than **Rs.6,84,78,630.00**

Explanatory notes to a) & b) :

Note 1:- Similar work(s) means “**Road works using bitumen and construction of footpath, drain, culvert etc.**”

Note 2:- Following enhancement factors will be used for the costs of works executed for bringing the financial figures to a common base value in respect of the works completed in past years.

Note 3:- The experience certificate of works executed in private sectors /organisations shall be considered for qualification, only on submission of TDS certificate along with work order and completion certificate, and also the details furnished in Annexure 4(a)&4(b), certified by Chartered Accountant with UDIN No..

Note 4:- Satisfactory Client /Owners' Certificate or documentary proof shall be submitted in support of the assignments / works performed and claimed by the tenderer to fulfil the eligibility criteria for qualification.

Note5:- A statement duly certified by the Chartered Accountant with UDIN No. showing the average annual Financial Turnover over the last 3

financial years and audited financial statements for the last three years shall be submitted.

Note6:- The works reckoned for the above purpose are those executed by the tenderers as prime contractor or proportionately as member of joint venture or as a sub-contractor, authorized and approved by the Employer of the work(s) against which the tenderer has claimed his experience; it will be considered for qualification only if documentary proof of such authorization / approval of the Employer are submitted.

3. **Other Eligibility Considerations**

3.1 Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- i) made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
- ii) record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.
- iii) not submitted complete documents as per clause 22 of “Instructions to Bidders”.

3.2 The bidders having EPF/ ESI registration certificates shall only be considered for qualification in the tenders, if applicable, as per EPF /ESI Acts.

5. **This work essentially comprises of the following :**

The overall scope of work is divided into three primary segments

(i) Part-A: Construction of new footpath over new drain & Utility duct along Bristow road from Hospital Junction to Udaan Gate Junction

This part comprises of dismantling of existing drainage & footpaths and construction of new footpath over new drainage system with ducts for electrical & data cables alongside Bristow Road between Hospital Junction and Udaan Gate Junction which includes the following works:

- (a) Demolition & Site Clearing:** Demolition of existing old concrete drains, taking out existing kerb stones, few flexible pavement areas and clearing interlocking paver blocks and clearing trees along the pathway zone.
- (b) Earthwork** excavation & Bedding concrete Earth work excavation for new trenches, culverts, road gully chambers and laying bedding concrete with 1:3:6 cement concrete.
- (c) Concrete & Structural Work:** Fabricating and casting the integrated drainage channels, electrical ducts, data cable ducts, and box culverts using RCC M25 grade.
- (d) Utility & Drainage Installation:** Laying 300 mm diameter R.C.C. pipes, installing 110 mm diameter PVC drainage pipes, and FRP 600mm dia manhole covers.
- (e) Finishing & Pedestrian Pathways:** Laying precast concrete factory made kerb stones, paving footpaths with interlocking factory-made paver blocks and installing steel frames for signage.
- (f) Canal Protection Work:** Pointing stone masonry walls along the adjacent peripheral canal

(ii) Part-B: Re-surfacing of Bristow Road from Hospital Junction To Udaan Gate Junction

This phase completely rehabilitates the flexible bituminous pavement of Bristow road from Hospital Jn. To Udaan Gate Jn and includes the following:

- (a) **Pavement Profiling:** Scarifying the existing road surface for surfacing and filling potholes with Wet Mix Macadam (WMM).
- (b) **Asphalt Paving Layer:** Providing and laying, 75 mm thick Dense Graded Bituminous Macadam (DBM) base course after applying bitumen emulsion tack coats and finishing with a 50 mm thick Bituminous Concrete wearing layer.
- (c) **Traffic Safety Infrastructure:** Providing thermoplastic road markings and Glow Studs to define vehicle lanes and a dedicated cycle track, installing retro reflective regulatory and warning signboards

(iii) Part-C: Electrical Works

This electrical scope covers “Electrical works for replacement of old light poles with New GI Lamp Poles along with led light fittings at BRISTOW ROAD (Police Station Junction to Ernakulam Toll)

The brief scope of work is as shown below.

- (a) SITC of 9/7m GI Octagonal light poles with luminaries, foundation etc. as per annexure.
- (b) SITC of 90W LED Street light luminaries on Street light poles of 9M/7M as required.
- (c) Dismantling and Re-installation, testing and commissioning of 7/9 Mtr long GI octagonal pole including necessary cabling, connections, supply of GI foundation bolts/Nuts as per size required etc. in complete and all related works as directed by the EIC for proper functioning of same.
- (d) SITC of Out Door (OD) Polycarbonate Lights control panel with timer, Contactor, Auto /M switch MCB etc as required including foundation.
- (e) SITC of Poly carbonate OD 160 A MV panel with 160 A 4P MCCB as Incomer and 125A 4P MCCB- 1 no., 63 A MCCB -4 nos including foundation.
- (f) SITC of Poly carbonate OD MV panel with 160 A 4P MCCB as Incomer and 125A 4P MCCB- 1 no., 63 A MCCB -4 nos with a Polycarbonate Lights control panel with timer, Contactor, Auto /M switch MCB etc as per schedule including foundation.
- (g) Supply of Poly carbonate Material Junction box, IP 65 with metric knockouts for cable entry, cable glands (2 nos), 16 A RYBN connector, SP MCB, supports for taking street light connection.
- (h) Supply & Laying of 110/40 MM DWC HDPE Pipe through underground by excavation /trenches/hard surfaces/removing pavement blocks etc refilling

as required.

- (i) Supply & Laying and of 4C x 4 sq mm Armoured CU, LT UG cable, 3.5C x 150 Sq.mm PVC insulated and PVC sheathed / XLPE power cable of 1.1 KV grade cable through DWC HDPE Pipe/ trenches etc.
 - (j) Supply and providing End termination /Straight joint for LT cables as per schedule.
 - (k) Road cutting for laying the cables and refilling after laying pipes, cables and Providing Cement concrete in excavated areas after proper consolidation.
 - (l) Providing RCC foundation with GI Bolts/Nuts etc. as per manufacturer recommendation including all materials for foundation as per the manufacturer drawing for 9/7 Meter pole by providing necessary template and all related works as directed by the EIC.
 - (m) Earthing of the installations with CU bonded rods/pipe earthing such as light poles etc.
 - (n) Dismantling of existing A/GI/street light poles for reinstallation and handing over of OH Lines to the Testing & Repairing section / scrape yard/ stores as instructed by EIC including transportation.
 - (o) Removing the existing 3C X 240/300 Sqmm 11 KV XLPE insulated UG cable and relaying the same in the new proposed RCC trench/ Duct at the side of the Road.
 - (p) Testing and commissioning of the entire system.
 - (q) SITC of 2 Mtr. Bollard lights/GI Poles including CC Foundation.
6. Bid Documents can be downloaded from the e-Tendering portal www.tenderwizard.com/COPT on the dates specified in the above table 2 given above by making online requisition. Bid Document will also be available in Cochin Port website (www.cochinport.gov.in) as well as Central Public Procurement (CPP) Portal which can be downloaded for submission. The cost of Bid Document shall be furnished in the form of Demand Draft / Pay Order/Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of FA & CAO, CoPA along with the submission of Bid. Payment can also be made online mode (NEFT/RTGS) as per Bank details at Annexure 15
7. The bidders need to obtain the one time User ID & password for log-in to in **e-Tendering** system from the service provider **KEONICS** by paying registration amount of **Rs.1124/-** by online Payment using Credit/Debit Card/Net banking or DD in favour of "KSEDCL, Bangalore".
8. The intending bidder must have valid Class-II or III digital signature certificate to submit the bid. For further details and to obtain the digital signature, please contact e-Tender Help Desk No. 080-49352000 / 9605557738.

9. Tenders shall be submitted “**online**” strictly in accordance with the Instructions to Tenderers and Terms & Conditions given in the tender document.
10. The bidder is responsible to download Addenda/ Amendments/ Errata/ Replies to the queries of the bidders etc., if any, issued by the Employer, from the website before submission of the bid. Any shortfall in submissions of the said Addenda/ Amendments/Errata/Replies to the queries of the bidders duly signed etc. along with the downloaded documents while submitting the bid will not be considered. Incomplete bid documents may be rejected.
11. All bids are to be submitted **online only** on the website www.tenderwizard.com/COPT. No Bids shall be accepted off-line (Hard copy).
12. Cochin Port Authority will not be held responsible for any technical snag or network failure during online bidding. It is the bidder’s responsibility to comply with the system requirements i.e. hardware, software and internet connectivity at bidder’s premises, to access the e-Tender portal. Under any circumstances, Cochin Port Authority shall not be liable to the bidders for any direct/indirect loss or damages incurred by them arising out of incorrect use of the e-Tender system or internet connectivity failures.
13. The bidder shall submit Originals of the following in a sealed cover **to The Chief Engineer, Cochin Port Authority, W/Island, Cochin – 682009, KERALA**, before opening date and time of the tender.
 - (i) DD / Bankers Cheque etc. towards the cost of tender document,
 - (ii) Demand Draft / Pay Order / Banker’s Cheque / Insurance Security Bond / BG etc. towards EMD,
 - (iii) Power of Attorney in favour of signatory(s) to the tender and (iv) Integrity Pact along with letter of submission.

Non submission of original financial documents towards cost of Tender document, EMD and Integrity Pact, before opening date and time, of the tender will be liable for rejection.

14. Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE’s) Bidders who are registered with District Industries Centre (DIC) or Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC) or Khadi and Village Industries Board (KVIB) or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) or directorate of Handicrafts and Handlooms or Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum or any other body specified by Ministry of MSME for similar nature of Works shall be eligible for issue of Bid Document free of cost and exemption from payment for issue of tender document & payment of EMD. They are required to submit documentary proof of such registration with QR code along with the offer, as detailed in Instructions to Bidders, for claiming the available exemptions and a scanned copy of Exemption Certificate duly notarized

shall be uploaded in the e- Tender Portal. Also, a Bid Security Declaration in the format mentioned in **Annexure-16** shall be submitted. If the Registration Certificate does not pertain to the Category of “Similar Works” mentioned above, the Tender will be rejected. Registered Start-ups as recognized by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) are exempted from payment of Bid Security / EMD.

15. **Integrity Pact (IP)** Integrity Pact (IP) shall cover this tender throughout its various phases, and IP would be deemed as a part of the contract through an appropriate provision. The bidders should sign and submit an Integrity Pact to be executed between the bidder and Cochin Port Authority along with the bid in a separate envelope superscribed —Integrity Pact in Technical Bid. Bids not accompanied by a duly signed —Integrity Pact shall be liable for rejection. IP would be implemented through the following Independent External Monitor (IEM) for this tender:
